## Council of Chairs Meeting Thursday, September 17, 2020 1:00 PM – 2:30 PM

- 1. Approval of the Summary notes from September 3, 2020.
- 2. Group Discussion
  - <u>Assessment Coordinators:</u> Dr. Parastou Feiz, Associate Dean, asked Chairs for the name of each department Assessment Coordinator.
  - **Spring Build:** Dr. Peter Williams, Senior Dean's Fellow, shared that the Spring Build has been extended to September 25. There will need a clean-up process that will run on September 28<sup>th</sup>. Dr. Williams asked Chairs to review all courses. In regard to face-to-face courses, Dr. Williams asked Chairs to provide a list before September 25<sup>th</sup> (if any).
  - <u>Budget Updates:</u> Michelle Fuller, Financial and Administrative Analyst, shared that the college budget should be distributed by the end of the month (end of September). The budget will be based on one-time funding and will be given in incremental. Michelle also shared that the Intra-Budget transfers will be accepted through October. She will meet with Department Administrative Coordinators to go over the deadlines.
  - Ethnic Studies Updates: CAL Leadership Team discussed various issues pertaining to the new Ethnic Studies (ES) requirement. Some major concerns include: (1) the law requires each CSU campus to offer course in ethnic studies by the fall of 2021; (2) the new ES requirement is being placed in lower division; (3) to fulfill the new ES requirement, the courses need to have ES prefix or cross-list with ES; and (4) the new Category F (ES) requirement may affect majors which have less than 6 units of free electives. Department chairs were encouraged to attend the GE forum to discuss Ethnic Studies requirement.
  - <u>CAL Talk Arts and Humanities in the Age of Pandemics:</u> Dean Rueyling Chuang spoke about the CAL Talk which is scheduled for Thursday, October 1<sup>st</sup> at 12 noon. Dean asked Chairs to please notify her if there is a calendar conflict.
  - <u>College Strategy and Plan for GI 2025:</u> Dean Chuang and Dr. Feiz shared that the College Strategy and Plan for Graduation Initiative 2025 is due on September 30<sup>th</sup>. Dr. Feiz will create a Google Doc that will be placed in the *CAL Chairs Drive* where Chairs can enter their ideas and strategies in tracking GI 2025. Council will meet next **Tuesday**, **September 22nd** to discuss the strategies that are entered on the Google Doc.
  - Revisiting Retreat Conversations on "Enhancing Faculty Success": Council discussed the Faculty Success strategies that were submitted during the start-of-the-year retreat. Dean asked Chairs to vote on their top 5 strategies which will be the priorities the college will focus on this year.
