He also has an MM in Trombone Performance from USC and a BA in Music from Cal Poly San Luis Obispo. Dr. Miller, a Southern California native, is in demand as a teacher and clinician acros California. Additionally, Mark is the Trombone Instructor at Pasadena City College where he also served as Assistant Band Director in 2015 and 2017. He was the conductor of the Symphonic Band at Cal State Los Angeles in 2019 and 2017.
